



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Touchstones Fellows program is a free virtual 8-week cohort-based professional learning opportunity that brings experienced and novice Touchstones teachers together for weekly and hands-on discussion leadership practice. Fellows will engage in the first nine lessons of our Exploring American Perspectives (EAP) volume - which exclusively includes works by African American and Black contributors - to explore themes of belonging, inclusion, equity, voice, leadership, and community.

FELLOWS WILL

- Build discussion leadership skills by facilitating one of the discussion meetings with advanced preparation and personalized support
- Examine assumptions and biases
- Practice working with others, regardless of perceived similarity or difference and build community with other educators
- Learn to better articulate ideas and formulate questions
- Earn a certificate for 18 hours of professional development, upon successful completion of the program
